# Code of Ethics, Confidentiality, Transition to new Board Discussion:

All Board Members are required to sign the Board Code of Ethics. C. Minton highlighted the Code for all members. Copies will be distributed by email for review and signature. The Roll was called for all members to agree to the Code of Ethics, with all verbally agreeing.

# League Presentation by J. Burgh and K. Deaton:

The Parkway League officially folded in November 2020. Four leagues are being considered.

- Big East (Eastern Suburbs of Pittsburgh and Westmoreland County)
  - No JV structure but play a "5<sup>th</sup> Quarter" scrimmage for developmental players.
  - o 6U is Flag Football.
  - Max weight for 12U is 165 lbs.
  - Travel distance is an concern.
- South Hills League (many former G19 teams in southern suburbs of Pittsburgh)
  - Grade based.
  - No JV program.
  - Max roster size is 16 players.
  - No 12U program.
- United League
  - North Pittsburgh Suburbs and Butler County.
  - SV North is a member. League will not accept two SV associations.
  - No JV structure.
  - Age Based.
- Western PA Youth Football League (Formerly Greene-Washington League)
  - Three former teams from Parkway are joining (Montour, West Allegheny, Baldwin)
  - Has JV structure
  - Grade based with age cutoff.
  - No max weight, skilled weight limit, one time weigh-in.
  - League handles all logistics for scheduling and referees.
- Recommendations from J. Burgh and K. Deaton
  - Maintain association with the Diocese of Pittsburgh League for 12U
  - Create a new 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Grade team.
  - Create JV structure for 12U if there are enough players.
  - o Join Western PA Youth Football League for all other levels.
- General discussion followed:
  - Logistics of collecting admission fee at Graham Park were discussed.
  - Pros and Cons of each league discussed.
  - 12U options discussed.
- J. Burgh made a motion for the Board to make a presentation via Zoom on January 25<sup>th</sup> to the General Membership with the recommendation to join the Western PA Youth

Football League. Executive Board Meeting to he held immediately afterwards to formally vote.

- Unanimously approved.

## Equipment:

- Football Uniforms
  - Discussion about new jerseys and pants.
  - M. Loebig indicated that pants are particularly in bad shape, many jerseys need to be retired due to excessive wear. Mike and Nate offered to investigate options.
  - Many associations have personalized jerseys for players each year rather than jerseys that are used year after year.
- Cheer
  - Will likely need new uniforms for some of the older girls. Poms need to be replaced.
- Helmet Reconditioning 207 total helmets, 39 will expire. Mike is getting quotes for reconditioning but need to move soon because of delayed spring football in the state.
  - Motion by A. Ferri to use Sportsmen's again for helmet reconditioning, provided it is in line with last year's fees. Second by B. Sutherland. Unanimously passed.
  - Motion by M. Loebig to only recondition the helmets that were used in 2020 or if their two-year reconditioning had expired. Second by A. Ferri. Motion unanimously carried.
  - Plan is to continue buying 25-30 helmets per year as about that many expire each year.

#### 2020 Budget Wrap-up and 2021 Discussion

- 2020 Books being finalized. We anticipate breaking even for the year.
- A. Ferri requested that all Board Members have their budget request before the February Board meeting. Vote on the annual Budget will take place at the February General meeting. Budget details will depend on the League we play in, associated fees for the league, and other expenditures.
- Capital Investment improvement to Graham Park for the township. Needs to be conducted in the next two years. Ideas due by summer 2021.
- ID Machine item has been budgeted, but not purchased yet.
