#### Football:

A question was raised regarding the 12U waitlist. M. Loebig indicated that players should be taken off the waitlist and moved to the roster based on seniority with the association first, followed by date registered. A. Feri indicated he would check the bylaws and report back if there was a formal policy on this.

# **Logan Renshaw Scholarships:**

The Board agreed unanimously to grant 5 awards of \$500 each based on the applications that were received. The remaining \$500 that was planned to be awarded will be pushed into next year's award pool.

## Fundraising:

The Board agreed unanimously to order the raffle tickets that are distributed at equipment handouts.

# Registration:

The Board unanimously agreed to reopen registrations for 7U, 9U, and 11U football, and all cheer except Mascots until June 12 to allow families to register who were undecided due to COVID19.

## **League Update:**

The Parkway League is operating business as usual for now, working as if the season will go on. There was a proposal at the last league meeting to allow 12 year old 6<sup>th</sup> graders by March 1 to play at the 11U level if there is no 12U program at that association. This was proposed by West Allegheny. SVJFAC suggested that smaller (weight TBD) or less-abled 12-year olds could also play down at 11U. No action taken on either motion by the league.

## Cheer:

The Board discussed whether there would be competitive cheer or if we would only do sideline cheering this year. Given the unknown status of competitions, including our own, a decision on this was tabled until more information is known.

## **General Discussion:**

B. Och was authorized to purchase an ID Badge machine and software so all coaches and authorized representatives can have ID Badges for games and sideline access.
