League Update:

The Parkway League has elected to fold for the season due to many associations being unwilling or unable to play due to COVID19.

C. Minton has had significant discussions with the Pittsburgh Catholic Diocese league about potentially joining with their four teams for this season as an option for the SVJFAC and perhaps several other associations seeking a league to play in. The Catholic Diocese League splits teams by grade level rather than age.

- There is no 7U program. Our 7U will be primarily in-house but may have games with Moon and NA.
- 3-4 Grade – no weight limits, developmental
- 5-6 Grade – Skill weight of 135, Max weight of 200 between tackles
- 7-8 Grade – Skill weight of 147, No max weight between tackles

5-6 and 7-8 teams have one weigh-in before season starts.

Heat Acclimation can begin on August 10, First Game on August 30.

There is no JV program so we will have to split the 9U and 11U teams and hold drafts.

A motion was made by C. Minton and seconded by A. Feri to join the Pittsburgh Catholic Diocese League for the 2020 Season only, adapting our teams to their system of grades and weights. Motion passed unanimously. The Board thanked Chris for all of his hard work and many hours spent finding us a league to play in this year.
